A \$10 bond is held until the DVD, or Video, is returned (without damage) at the end of the lending period. An additional \$10 may be requested to help purchase a replacement.

If a DVD or Video is lost, or damaged then the bond will be kept unless an acceptable replacement is provided.

If the DVD or Video is to be couriered then an additional, non refundable, amount of \$10 is payable (includes return courier cost)

Unless by prior arrangement the lending period is for up to 7 days at any one time. An extra 7 days is allowed if being couriered.

DVDs and Videos are only to be lent out to active NZAC Club members. A Membership number is to be recorded in the log book.

Please take good care of the items you are borrowing, so that other members may continue to enjoy viewing the films.
