Harper and Johnston, January 1891
- Sealey **2639m** Popular both summer and winter.
Excellent views north and south.

OHAU REGION

- Hopkins **2682m** Dominating presence at the head of
the valley. Some unclimbed ridges too.
- Percy Smith **2469m** Impressive, has there been a second
Ascent on any from the west?
- Ward **2644m** Rock or ice, summer or winter, ridge
or face, take your choice.
- Dasler Pinnacles **2303m** Finest viewpoint in the valley.
Running shoe ascents in summer.
- Rabbiters Peak **2289m** Highest peak in the attractive
North Temple Valley.
- Matuka Atua **2537m** "Stand Apart" take a fast day trip to
the top of the Ben Ohau Range.

LANDSBOROUGH

- Fettes **2545m** Visible from as far away as Malte, a
Must for any Landsborough trip.
- Dechen **2630m** New Zealand's only ice cap glacier.
Ski off this one.
- Hooker **2652m** Impressive West Coast massif.
Cruisey from Mark's Flat.

CHALLENGE

RAUKUMARA RANGE 1752m First point to see the sun in Hikurangi hemisphere.

TONGARIRO

Ngauruhoe **1839m** Classic volcanic cone and scree run. J C Bidwill

Tahurangi **2797m** Climb our biggest volcano for something a little different

TARANAKI

Taranaki **2518m** New Zealand's most dangerous Mountain. It's certainly claimed the most lives.

TARARUAS

Hector 1529m Check out the Wellington Hills, try your Navigation skills in the Takararas.

TRAVERS RANGE AND SPENSER MOUNTAINS

Hopeless **2278m** Can't be difficult as the name suggests

Travers **2338m** Tackle this peak from the appropriately named Summit Creek.

Franklyn **2340m** Dominant and highest of the Nelson Lakes peaks.

Paske **2232m** A quick scamper up the Rainbow River And Paske Creek to Paske Hut.

Faerie Queen **2237m** An accessible Spencer Mountain climb.

BRANCH RIVER

Scotts knob 2185m Climb this when in Marlborough.

INLAND KAIKOURAS

Tapiae-Uenuku **2877m** Follow the rainbow to Sir Edmund Hillary's First 9000ft mountain.

Alarm **2877m** The south face is a mean proposition in winter. Amazing gully systems.

SEAWARD KAIKOURAS

Manakau **2609m** Definitely some mana to be gained here. A Wellington section specialty.

Te Ao Whekere **2595m** No octopus here, but watch the cloud.

ARTHURS PASS

Franklin **2088m** A great view point to watch the loonies run the Coast to Coast.

Rolleston **2270m** A very popular peak.

Phipps **1984m** A variety of routes for all season including some good rock.

Murchison **2399m** Venture up the Waimakariri River to the **highest** peak in the park.

Avalanche **1754m** A good first peak in winter conditions, or a pleasant walk in summer.

RAKAIA HEADWATERS

Whitcombe **2644m** A long way from the East side, or try it from The Wanganui River.

Evans **2637m** Can you crack it? Eluded John Pascoe for years.

Malcolm Peak **2514m** Distinctive peak, widely visible.

ARROWSMITHS

Arrowsmiths **2795m** A big brute with routes on all sides, but easiest from the Lawrence.

Jagged **2720m** As name suggests, sharp stuff.

North Peak **2659m** An excellent climb from the Lawrence Valley.

RANGITATA HEADWATERS

Warrior **2591m** The highest peak in the Armoury Range
Tyndall **2524m** Access from the Garden of Eden

GODLEY

D'Archic **2865m** Approach from the Forbes
Sibbald **2804m** A winter ski ascent is worth considering.
The Thumbs **2547m** Check its impressive appearance from the highway at Ashburton.
Loughnan **2576m** A challenge, very few ascents of this peak.
Broderick **2637m** An aesthetic peak with great all round views from the summit.

LIEBIG RANGE

Tamaki **2444m** Avoid the crowds, stroll up the Murchison to the meadow at Liebig Hut.
Nun's Veil **2737m** A fast day trip with stunning views of Cook, Tasman and everything else.

MALTE BRUN RANGE

Hamilton **2997m** By the graceful arte on the Murchison Glacier side.
Malte Brun **3159m** Many type of routes to choose from in all conditions.
Chudleigh **2954m** Try the east face or a traverse of all three peaks would be challenging.

UPPER TASMAN

Ellie de Beaumont **3111m** How about a traverse from the West Coast.
Hochstetter Dome **2823m** Start your Tasman ski run from here.
Green **2828m** Interesting ice climbs here in winter, or rock in summer.
The Minarets **3056m** Add both to your list of 3000m peaks.
Haidinger **3068m** Seldom climbed from the East.

LOWER TASMAN

Haast **3138m** A traverse of the three peaks has to be a good challenge.
Tasman **3498m** Superb ice mountain and finest viewpoint in the country.
Cook **3766m** Top of New Zealand.
Anzac Peaks **2561m and 25321m** Samuel Turner soloed the mountain via the gully routes in 1917.
Nazomi **2913m** Some superb rock here.
Pibrac **2516m** Check out the South Ridge and Caroline Face of Cook while there.

HAWEA REGION

Brewester **2423m** Very popular peak in the Haast Pass region. Ice on the face in winter.
Barth **2431m** Rapid access from the Ahuriri Valley and Canyon Creek.

ASPIRING REGION

Alba **2355m** A neglected mountain with some tremendous routes, fly in to Siberia.
Pollus **2542m** Jetboat up the Wilkin to this classically named peak.
Stargazer **2341m** With a name like this you have to climb it.
Aspiring **3027m** A stunning mountain from all angles. There are alternatives to the ramp.
Dragonfly **2165m** Away from the hordes, and super views onto the east face of Popes Nose.
Maori **2507m** receives few ascents and only recently climbed by the South Face.
Ionia **2249m** A long way away – enticing when viewed from Aspiring.

OLIVINES

- Climax **2432m** Even further away than Ionia, on the remote Olivine Ice Plateau.
- Somnus **2281m** Much more accessible, and the tallest of the Humboldt mountains.

FORBES RANGE

- Earnslaw **2816m** First climb by the major gully on the Northern side.
- West Peak **2612m** Could be some ice routes round here in winter conditions.
- Sir William **2274m** Climb it in period attire.
- Clarke

REMARKABLES

- Triple Cone **2340m** Also known to the locals as Single Cone. An easy scramble from the skifield.

EYRE MOUNTAINS

- Eyre Peak **1968m** Check out the Mavora Lakes and Eyre Mountains.

DARRANS

- Christina **2502m** Close to the road but a long way up.
- Sabre **2167m** Spectacular fang with a great rock. Test your technical skills here.
- Talbot **2110m** A good climb to take beginners on.
- Tutoko **2746m** A must in every climber career.

FIORDLAND

- Mitre Peak **1692m** It's one of the most photographed, but least climbed peaks in NZ.
- Pembroke **2000m** Add a bit of spice, approach it by fishing boat from Milford.
- Flat Top **2292m** Last great unclimbed face.

- Irene **1879m** deepest Fiordland explorers will tell you about this one.

FRANZ JOSEF GLACIER

- Spencer **2796m** A ski mountaineering objective from Almer Hut, routes grade 1-4.
- Rudolf **2730m** A Hamish MacInnes route on the west, but unclimbed from Tasman.

FOX GLACIER

- Barnicoat **2821m** Cruz grade 17 from Fox.
- Torres **3160m** Talk to Geoff Gabities about routes.
- Lendenfield **3200m** A good objective from Pioneer Hut. Plenty of choice routes.
- Douglas **3087m** A must if you are at Pioneer. Back up all abseils.

LA PEROUSE GLACIER

- Vancouver **3309m** several routes on the west. Watch for rockfall on the east side.
- Magellan **3065m** Spot the outs on this mountain by two former club presidents.
- Drake **2974m** Scened of the hardest rock routes. completed thus far in the Alps.

HOOKER/STRAUCHON GLACIER

- Hicks **3218m** A top playground on both north and south faces.
- La Perouse **3081m** Think about your routes on and off this one.
- Unicorn **2560m** outstanding quality alpine rock routes.
- Lean Peak **2364m** First ascent by Freda du Faur and Peter Graham.
