Training Opportunities

Training is the cornerstone of the knowledge and skill base within our club. The Section has previously provided advice to members about cost effective training both in Australia & NZ – including both volunteer-based as well as professional training. Whilst it is unknown how many

members took the opportunity to up-skill in this way, it has been disappointing that very few members have availed themselves of the \$200 training subsidy offered by the Section for such training.

During 2024, the Section is planning to further develop training opportunities for Section members. We propose to develop some specific and tailored training specifically for Australian members. We are currently in discussions with a NZ based professional guide who has offered to consider putting together some training packages including both rock and mountaineering. This guide will be based in Australia for a few months as well, so training could be either in NZ or Australia.

To help develop these, feedback is required from members:

- 1. An indication of numbers who might be interested in such training
- 2. Type of training rock or mountaineering
- 3. Level of training required beginner, intermediate, advanced, or special purpose?
- 4. Preferred location of such training

Please make an effort to provide feedback as we need some direction from members to make this work. Further details will be provided if this proposal gets up.
